BACKGROUND

The war in Sudan has been ongoing for 6 months, during which people in Sudan have lived through unparalleled violence. As a result, more than 4.5 million were forced to flee Khartoum into and outside Sudan. Those displaced are now without shelter, food, and healthcare.

SAMA's humanitarian relief aims to alleviate the hardship of internally displaced persons (IDPs). To achieve that, SAMA deployed full-time staff on the ground to coordinate its collaboration with local implementing partners.

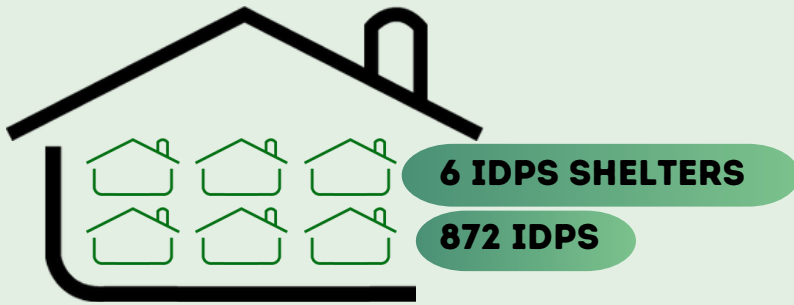

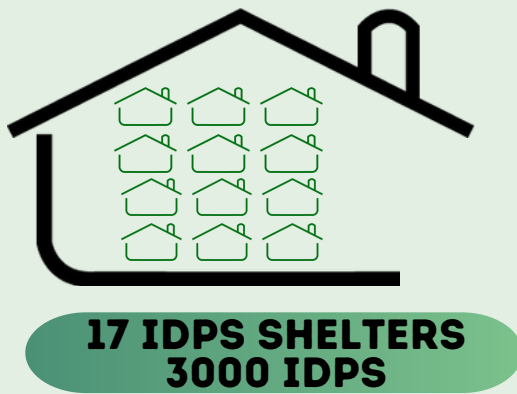

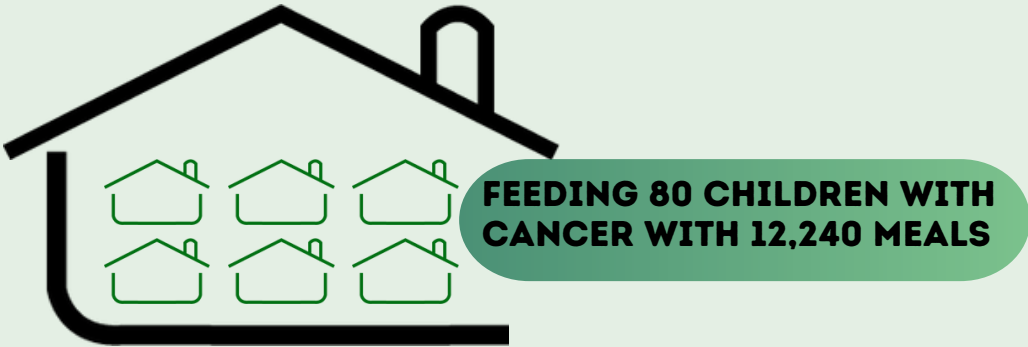
