Key Responsibilities:

- Act as the primary contact point for the "We Are All Values" organization (WAV), ensuring smooth communication between SAMA and WAV throughout the mission.
- Monitor WAV's progress and complete various tasks and assignments related to the mission's objectives, contributing to the successful implementation of humanitarian activities.
- Collaborate with the Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) officer to track and assess the mission's progress, ensuring that all project goals and deliverables are met on time.
- Write the mission report summarizing key outcomes, challenges, and lessons learned, to be submitted at the end of each mission.
