Join the Dr. Isam Osman Mobile Rescue Team, an initiative of the Sudanese American Medical Association (SAMA), to deliver essential healthcare services to underserved communities. As part of this mission, you will work alongside a multidisciplinary team to provide compassionate care and address urgent medical needs.

General Expectations

- Travel with the team from Port Sudan to Sinkat for the 7-day mission from December 23 to December 29, 2024.
- Attend an in-person (for local healthcare professionals) or Zoom (for visiting doctors) meeting with the SAMA Team in Port Sudan.
 - In-person attendance will be at the Dr. Bushra Ibnauf Center for Learning in Port Sudan, Sudan.
- Collaborate with the project manager to ensure successful completion of the mission
- Compassion and a strong commitment to humanitarian service.
- Ability to work collaboratively in a resource-limited setting.
- Flexibility and adaptability to challenging environments.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.

Requirements- For visiting doctors

- This is a **voluntary position**. Participants are contributing their time and expertise to provide critical healthcare services to underserved communities.
- Attending/consultant/specialist level
- Active medical license in good standing
- Current/Valid Sudanese passport holder (Sudan government regulations)
- Cover the cost of their airline tickets to Port Sudan
- Cover the cost of their accommodation in Port Sudan (Travel and accommodation during the mission in Sinkat will be covered by SAMA)

Requirements- for local healthcare professionals

- Based in Port Sudan, Sudan
- Posses an active license to practice in Sudan (until May 2023)
- For doctors, the minimum qualification required is a **Medical Officer** or higher.
- At least **1–2 years of clinical experience** is preferred, especially in rural or resource-limited settings.

Roles and Responsibilities

Mobile team members will have the following responsibilities based on their roles:

Doctors (Visiting and Local)

- Assist with the selection of medications and medical supplies for the mission
- Conduct medical consultations, diagnose illnesses, and develop treatment plans.
- Perform minor procedures as needed within the mission's capabilities.
- Provide training and mentorship to local healthcare providers to build sustainable healthcare capacity.
- Collaborate with team members to assess and address community health needs.

Nurses

- Provide direct patient care, including administering medications, dressing wounds, and monitoring vital signs.
- Assist doctors in managing patient care during consultations and treatments.
- Educate patients and caregivers on disease prevention and health maintenance.
- Support logistical and operational tasks to ensure smooth clinic operations.

Pharmacist Assistants

- Assist with the selection of medications for the mission
- Dispense medications according to prescriptions provided by the medical team.
- Maintain accurate inventory and records of dispensed medications.
- Educate patients on proper medication use and potential side effects.
- Assist in organizing and managing the mobile pharmacy.

Lab Technicians

- Assist with the **selection of laboratory supplies** for the mission.
- Collect samples and maintain proper infection control measures.
- Conduct diagnostic tests as requested by the medical team.
- Maintain and operate laboratory equipment in resource-limited settings.
- Ensure accurate recording and reporting of test results.

Volunteers

- Assist with logistical support before and during the mission
- Provide administrative support such as patient registration and record-keeping.
- **Assist with data collection** to support program monitoring and evaluation.
- Help manage supplies and coordinate non-medical activities during the mission.

Compensation

Compensation is only available for healthcare professionals based in Port Sudan who join the Dr. Isam Osman Mobile Rescue Team for this mission as follows:

Healthcare professional	Compensation
Local doctors (in Port Sudan)	SDG 400,000
Pharmacist assistant (in Port Sudan)	SDG 300,000
Lab technician (in Port Sudan)	SDG 300,000
Volunteer (in Port Sudan)	SDG 100,000

- Payment will be issued in SDGs
- Payment will be issued through Bankak as follows
 - 30% will be paid before the mission
 - 70% will be paid after completing the mission and returning to Port Sudan.
- Travel and accommodation expenses will be covered by SAMA
