The **SAMA Internship Program** offers a dynamic, hands-on learning experience designed to immerse interns in impactful projects. Interns are directly enrolled in **various SAMA initiatives**, providing them with practical, real-world exposure to nonprofit operations.

Duration

January 1, 2025 - June 30, 2025 (Maximum)

Essential Selection Criteria

- Reflects SAMA values of Excellence, integrity, and kindness
- Based in Cairo, Egypt, regardless of nationality.
- Applicants must be currently enrolled as students or have graduated within the past three years
- Early-career video editor with a passion for visual communication.
- Familiarity with video editing tools.
- Has access to a personal laptop and reliable internet source



Desirable Criteria

- Certification in English language competency e.g. OET, IETLS ...
- Has a LinkedIn account (or willing to create one) to post SAMA content

Skills Acquired During the SAMA Internship Program (Learn by Doing)

The SAMA Internship Program offers a unique opportunity for interns to develop a diverse set of practical and professional skills. By actively participating in SAMA projects, interns will gain expertise in the following areas:

Core Skills

1. Presentation Skills:

 Learn to craft and deliver compelling presentations, including SAMA presentations, tailored for diverse audiences.

2. Project Management Skills:

 Acquire the ability to plan, execute, and manage projects effectively, working collaboratively within a team.

3. IT and Digital Tools Proficiency:

- Master essential tools and platforms to enhance productivity and collaboration:
 - Google Suite: Develop advanced skills in Gmail, Slides, Sheets, Docs, and Calendar.
 - **Zoom:** Manage virtual meetings, webinars, and online sessions efficiently.
 - YouTube: Utilize video content for outreach, education, and engagement.
 - **Trello:** Organize tasks and streamline project workflows with ease.

In-Service Training Access:

In addition to hands-on experience, interns gain access to a curated library of **self-paced**, **free courses** as part of the in-service training program. These courses are designed to enhance clinical and organizational skills, providing ongoing opportunities for growth.

Expectations for this position

- Create videos from raw materials including photos and short clips
- Learn and use **Pictory** or similar Al-powered video editing tools effectively.
- Produce high-quality and visually appealing videos every month.
- Seek feedback and refine video-making skills throughout the internship.



2025 Videos schedule:

The intern is expected to create one video per month with the following themes:

October	Donor appreciation : Showcase how donor contributions have made a difference, including testimonials.

Commitment/time burden

- The intern is expected to be available online on Saturdays from 1 PM to 7 PM Cairo Time
 - Complete pending tasks,
 - Work with SAMA leadership, staff, interns
 - Zoom sessions
- Offline completion of tasks during the week

Willingness to cross-cover

- Allocation of positions is dependent on availability, all interns should be willing to cover gaps as they arise.
- Willingness to cover gaps is a requirement for recruitment.
- Unwillingness to fill a gap in service will result in a negative performance evaluation.

Recruitment & Retention

- All interns are evaluated at 1 month and 3 months
- Vacant positions are announced through the SAMA website, social media
- The selection and Review committee reviews applications and selects the best fit for the position after a formal interview

Poor Performance

- In the event of poor performance, interns can be relieved from their responsibilities at the end of the month.
- Examples include but are not limited to:
 - Code of Conduct Policy Breach
 - Confidentiality Policy Breach
 - Consistent inability to perform assigned tasks

Absence/Termination

- If interns cannot attend the Saturday meeting then they should submit an online form requesting leave and outlining the duration & reason for absence. In the same form, they should report on the tasks assigned on the Trello board
- If an intern misses two consecutive meetings or four non-consecutive meetings, then further absences will result in deductions from the stipend, i.e. unpaid absence
- If an intern misses four consecutive meetings or eight non-consecutive meetings, then their internship is terminated



Leave for examinations

- Interns can take up to one month of unpaid leave to prepare and sit for examinations
- Absence for more than one month leads to termination to vacate the position to a more available candidate

Performance Evaluation, Letters of Recommendation

 Will be issued by the Program co-directors on request based on performance after completing 6 months.

- Expected stipend: \$100 per month
