



Achievements


\$2,000 WORTH OF MEDICAL SUPPLIES

Context

The Dr. Isam Osman Humanitarian Mission series honors the legacy of Dr. Isam Osman by addressing healthcare gaps in underserved regions of Sudan.



Mission Three focused on enhancing trauma and critical care services in Port Sudan Teaching Hospital by delivering essential medical supplies and providing targeted training for local doctors. This mission aligns with SAMA's ongoing efforts to strengthen local healthcare systems and improve patient outcomes in critical and emergency care.

- To deliver trauma and critical care-related medical supplies to Port Sudan Teaching Hospital, Port Sudan, Sudan
- To train local healthcare professionals in approach to trauma patients and Ultrasound techniques in Port Sudan Teaching Hospital, Port Sudan, Sudan

Arrival and Welcoming

- Meetings: Coordination meeting with Dr. Shaza Alkashif, Consultant of Emergency Medicine at Port Sudan Teaching Hospital, to plan learning activities.
- Preparation: Finalized invoices from the vendor and submitted the purchase order for medical supplies.

Challenges

Preparation Issues for Training Sessions

 Procurement: Medical supplies purchased locally in Port Sudan and delivered to the Dr. Bushra Ibnauf Center.



Insufficient Number of Invoices

- The supply list provided to one of the vendors, Elaf Ezz, lacked detailed quantities for the required items. This oversight resulted in the vendor being unable to issue an invoice.
- Despite the goal of obtaining three invoices from vendors for comparison and selection, only one was secured due to logistical and communication gaps. Recommendations



Lessons learned

- Clear and consistent communication is essential among team members and external vendors.
- Detailed and verified supply lists must be shared to avoid delays and misunderstandings.
- A standardized procurement process can help streamline vendor selection and ensure all requirements are met.

The **Dr. Isam Osman Mobile Rescue Teams** are short missions designed to bring essential medical care and training to underserved communities in remote areas. These seven-day missions deploy healthcare professionals from Port Sudan to regions where access to care is limited, providing emergency support, trauma training, and essential supplies to local providers.

The next mission is scheduled for **December 2024** and will focus on the community of **Sinkat in the Red Sea State**.
